

Draft Minutes for C.A.R.S. Committee

April 12th, 2017

- Meeting called to order at 09:09 A.M.
- March minutes approved
- Patrick Sennett was at this meeting and advised:
 - o We are almost ready to send data to the State- still finding some differences on validity and adjusting items when this is found
 - o Auto Posting or manual posting of runs was discussed and it was agreed to have calls auto post to State as you post it to the cloud on a motion by Markus Rill and second by Mark Lindgren. If changes are made it will resend to the State and it will override the previous record unless it then became a non-valid record. This does not have a window it is unlimited.
 - When we do turn this auto post feature on it there will be a few weeks it will be running slow until they system catches up posting all the previous calls, but after that it should be faster.
 - Patrick states he will keep an eye on the “Data Exchange”; which is what our records go thru when down loading to the State; because if a record doesn’t pass a State rule this is where it will sit or get clogged up.
 - o Patrick should us his own MPR he is coming up with; when he has it more finished he will bring it back
 - o Patrick is going to make more validity rules for PEA and multi select under “ evitals.03”
 - o Patrick is going to move the “Member performing procedure” from the top right corner to at the top, but what appears more in the procedure.
 - Also going to see if he can add a validity rule to it.
- Hospital print out form almost all complete and approved.
 - o When printing you need a wireless connection to create the PDF.
 - o Subpoena print out form almost complete.
- NWCH wireless printing is working you may need the printers loaded to your tablet.
- CAD download was not working properly at the end of March and it took almost 2 weeks to get fixed. We will find a better and faster way to get these issues fixed in the future as we could not get it narrowed down to who’s “Problem” it was to fix. It appears this time to not be Image Trend, but NWCD and / or ID Networks.
- Service Defined Questions can be made “required” at Service Level with a 1 point value assigned.
 - o Go under Resources
 - o Then Service Defined Questions
 - o Choose “Yes” if you want to do this
- Motion by Jim Denna to “Pursue development of a Cardiac Arrest real time Power Tool” and second by Paul Pacific. Sam Parry and Joe Albert will start a committee and look into this.
- A class to be set up in the near future to help teach a representative from each agency to become a Super User.
- Discussion on activating the new CPR and 2 Airway Power Tools before May 1st, with a motion by Markus Rill, second by Steve Hernandez; it was read from minutes that Connie requested we activated these May 1st, but Dr. Jordan felt since we are not deactivating anything and just added additional resources this would be fine; and motion carried.
- Discussion on 4 lead documentation in Vitals Power Tool and 12 lead / pacing / defibrillation documentation in Monitor Power Tool
 - o Also that some CE’s did not have all the attachments made up from PBPI and CARS on the above, Dr. Jordan advised he would look into it and they will try to make sure next time all information gets passed on better.
