

"JumpSTART" Pediatric Triage

Red: Priority 1

- Respirations < 15 or >45
- Apneic & breathes after opening airway
- Breathes after 5 rescue breaths
- No pulse w/ RR 15-45
- Unresponsive / Inap. pain response
- Uncontrolled Bleeding

Yellow: Priority 2

Can't walk; RR 15-45; + pulse;
 "A", "V" or appropriate pain response

Green: Priority 3

- Can walk: "Walking Wounded"
- May be infants that appear to have no major injuries
- Direct to a specific location for secondary triage

Remember: START is only for <u>initial</u> triage!!! ALL patients <u>MUST</u> be reevaluated for life-threatening and other injuries using secondary triage

Black: Priority 0

- No breathing after airway opened and 5 rescue breaths given
- No respiration & no palpable pulse
