Dear NWC EMSS Paramedic:

We are delighted that Northwest Community Hospital has been chosen as the official healthcare provider for the 2012 Ryder Cup, to be held September 25-30 at Medinah Country Club. This is a great honor, giving us the opportunity to participate in one of golf's premier events.

This partnership requires a significant commitment. We need volunteers, including paramedics, nurses and physicians trained and experienced in advanced cardiac and trauma life support.

The PGA, Ryder Cup, Medinah Country Club, and NCH have developed a detailed plan to ensure responsiveness in case of medical emergencies. There will be rapid response teams of paramedics deployed strategically on the course, mobile stretcher golf-cart teams, and stationary medical trailers staffed with medical personnel.

The volunteer registration process is now underway. Any qualified NWC EMSS paramedic can indicate their interest to be a volunteer. All volunteers must be credentialed. Volunteers will be chosen based on how well their skills align with the specific needs of this commitment. We ask that anyone interested should commit to work a minimum of two eight-hour shifts.

Volunteers will be given an identification badge that will allow them access to the entire event. Thus, volunteers can attend the event, as a spectator, when they are not scheduled. Volunteers will also receive a Ryder Cup - Northwest Community medical team polo shirt/vest and hat (if scheduled outdoors) that are being designed especially for this event.

As the Ryder Cup is an international showcase for some of the world's best golfers, our involvement in this event demands a serious commitment on the part of the Northwest Community medical volunteer corps. If you are interested in being considered for the PGA volunteer staff, please fill out the attached application and FBI background check consent form and return these forms by May 1. We hope to have the roster of volunteers identified and scheduled by mid-June.
