A Peer I and II class calendar needs to be established. A lengthy discussion on how to meet the requirements of a Peer I & II Educator. Plus, a method that a Peer II could still be able to present Peer I level of Education (meaning BLS). P. Dyer discussed tracking and how we could maintain/manage the level of recognition. The sub-committee is looking at the present material as a “concept” while continuing to develop the details. It was suggested that video based education could help enhance consistency. If a System approved video was developed, a consistent message would be presented on a practical topic. A sub-committee was developed that would work on System-approved videos. Sub-committee members – Dr. Ortinau, D. Schultz, Robyn Mazzdini and J. Schneidwind. A draft of the proposed Peer I & II will be updated and resent. The committee is seeking feedback from NWCEMSS. • EMT Gap Analysis – The new National Standards have been adopted. This included new outlines and skills (required assessments, field ride time). The new EMT class would be utilized to workout the details of the new objectives. This then could be linked to the Peer Educator who could disseminate the information at the agency level. • Paramedic CE Material – No discussion • Policy Updates - The C-2 (ConEd) and E-4 (Modular Proficiency) were reviewed for proposed changes. Additional changes were recommended during the discussion. G. Fabsits would update the Policies and they would be sent out for further review and any additional comments at January's meeting.
