The benefit is that all will have a common starting point for field bridge use. The base template can be re-customized as time moves on by each agency. Dr. Ortinau commented that this is the first time the System is doing education like this. 11/12 train-the-trainer rollout is an open invitation to coordinators, EdCom member, etc. This session will be for feedback and is not to replace the train-the-trainer class. S. Wood commented that 90% of the CE will be the agency's (superuser) educator. It is recommended that a computer not be present at the CE; they do not want the focus to be on the computer but on the CE. Department educators must be dedicated to teaching the class. It was stated that the data needed by many agencies is best gathered by the paramedic at the point of contact. N. Unti asked how it would be addressed if unable to complete the 200 slides. The Pwr.Pt would be made available after the class. G. Fabsits thanked the sub-committee for their work.</li> </ul>
