Minutes & Agenda	Addition to agenda: Paramedic class PCR review. Motion to approve last month's minutes made by Luke, second by Ryan. All in favor, motion granted, minutes approved.	
Old Business  a. Norepi Screen  b. ImageTrend  conference	a. <b>Norepi Screen</b> 393 incidents reviewed. Norepi administered 11 times. 20% of the runs were flagged as "should have received norepi but did not" – we need to look at those closer to figure out why these pts went untreated. Much discussion about IV starts being unsuccessful (less starts over the past few years since protocols have come out with not wanting IVs on pts unless need IV meds or fluids) and then lack of fluids delivered due to no vascular access. Seems to be hesitation in starting IOs on conscious patients, so these patients just end up going without vascular access, hence no fluids or norepi administered. Continued discussion about the results of the norepi screen. <b>b. ImageTrend conference</b> – Chiefs approved to send on PBPI member and one CARS committee member. Ryan Rasche will be attending for PBPI.	
New Business a. 2018 Screen schedule b. Cardiac arrest and naloxone screens	<ul> <li>a. 2018 Screen schedule – Jason presented the screen schedule for the remainder of 2018. Minimal discussion. Cardiac arrest data for 2018 is being removed from our normal screen schedule since Dr. Jordan is starting a cardiac arrest sub-committee and those calls will be analyzed via that committee.</li> <li>b. Cardiac arrest and naloxone screens – Cardiac arrest and naloxone screen – we will be looking at 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of 2017 for these screens. Jason will email out instructions and screens, please complete and send back to him by end of month.</li> </ul>	b. Members should complete their 4 <sup>th</sup> quarter arrest/naloxone screens and submit to Jason by end of the month.
System Updates	<ul> <li>Latest EMT class just had 100% pass rate on national registry exam. New class underway in January.</li> <li>Paramedic students should be coming out to field first week of March. Preceptor classes should be completed this month.</li> <li>CPR cards from AHA are now \$17. So the system has a ½ sheet that they are willing to accept for those up to date on CPR, just need it filled out by your agency EMS coordinator.</li> <li>Region is trying to get more information on CHEMPACK program and updating contact information on locations where these caches are held.</li> </ul>	

	<ul> <li>Still much non-compliance about calling in certain BLS refusals, need to do something so we have a better understanding about who requires a call to OLMC.</li> <li>Illinois strategic plan is being updated, and so the system is trying to keep abreast of those changes so they can be ready to implement any necessary changes.</li> <li>Mobile Integrated Health should be rolled out late spring/early summer within a few towns on a trial basis. If successful, the hope is to expand to other agencies.</li> <li>New SOPs by November. Any feedback about upcoming SOPs, provide to the system.</li> </ul>
