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New Business Webex Presentation of PulsePoint Slishman Traction Splint	PulsePoint did an online presentation of their CPR app that alerts general public users that are trained in CPR if there is a cardiac arrest in a public setting within a predetermined distance from their location. R&D discussed the pros & cons of purchasing and using the app. The system as a whole had very few public cardiac arrest and even less where CPR was not being performed prior to arrival (PTA). Scott (BGFD) presented the Slishman traction splint as an alternative traction splint. The Slishman traction splint is easier to apply and use relative to our other devices. It also has the added benefit that it doesn't extend past the end of the foot so loading pts into ambulances becomes easier as well.	If departments wanted to implement the PulsePoint app Dr. Jordan stated he would support them but there was no recommendation or stance made by R&D as a committee.
