RE: PEER EDUCATOR CLASSES

Stations for Peer I Class

1. Airway

Manual airway maneuvers; oral and nasal airways Bag valve mask, including use of the ResQPOD and 2 man BVM

2. Drug administration

SL nitroglycerin Obtaining a glucose reading Drawing medication from a vial and administering naloxone IN, and Glucagon IN Epi pen Autoinjector; MDI with albuterol

- 3. Helmet removal, c-collar application; use of the scoop stretcher; and full spine motion restriction
- 4. KED
- 5. Traction Splints
- 6. Restraints

Stations for Peer II Class

- 1. **Airway management** CPAP; adult King / Adult DAI intubation (with drug dose and sequencing; confirm placement with capnography)
- 2. Airway management Cric needle and surgical
- 3. Electrical therapy rhythm identification; pace/cardioversion/defibrillation in a declining patient scenario
- 4. 12 L (lead placement; acquire, interpret implications for NTG delivery)
- 5. Vascular access; EZ IO on peds; calculating dextrose and midazolam doses for children
- 6. **Trauma mgt:** Assess to discover tension pneumo; needle decompression; fentanyl delivery using new dosing and MAD device for pain

Each candidate will be expected to teach/test the skill with a System educator as their "student".

The "students" will be making lots of mistakes that the Peer Educator candidate will be expected to detect and coach to the desired performance level using the System's lab manual skill sheets. The purpose is not for the Peer educator candidate to perform the skill. We need to ensure that they can teach it and sign off their peers, attesting to skill competency.

Each station should take no longer than 30 minutes to complete. Many will take less. A candidate will be allowed to re-teach one station if necessary. They may be asked to remediate and come to another class if their ability to coach these skills has not yet met expectations.
