Paramedic Class Report

November 18, 2016

Update to class outcomes F15/S16

30 students started class; 27 students completed the class and were eligible to take a credentialing exam. Attrition rate: 10%.

- One student has not taken a written exam due to needed accommodation and clarification from the NREMT. That was granted in November and he has been encouraged to test ASAP.
- One student finished the field internship on an extended IEP and was authorized to take the State exam. He passed on the first attempt.
- One student who failed the NREMT exam 3 times, was authorized to take the State exam and passed on the first attempt.

25 attempted the NREMT written exam

25 of candidates have passed the NR practical exam.
