

**All NWC EMSS NON-Transport vehicle (MedEngine) inspections are due to IDPH by 9-30-2020.**

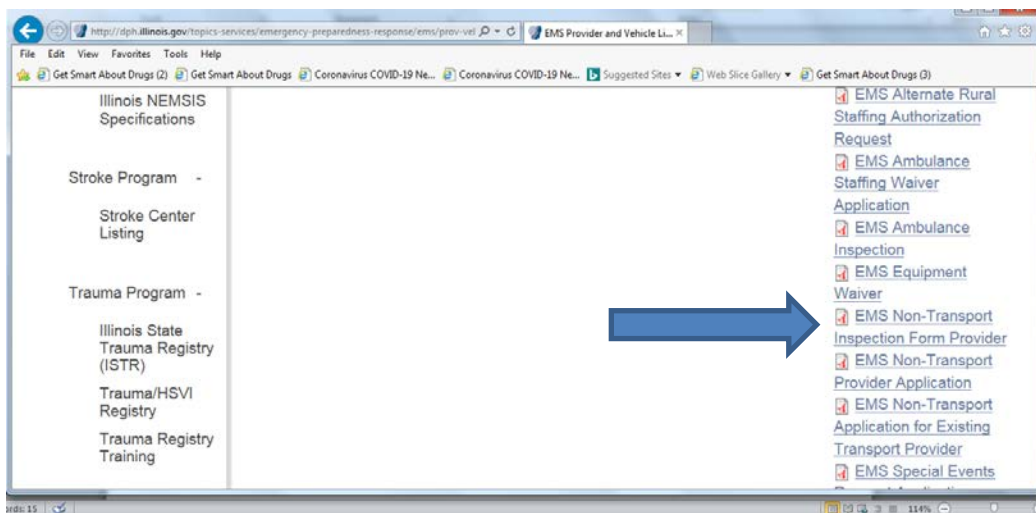
The IDPH Non-transport inspection form looks like this. It is a PDF fillable form and usually cannot be saved to a file as a template. Access the form directly from the IDPH EMS website (see below) on an electronic device, fill it in and print.

**Please note:**

- Each VIN number is 17 numbers or letters. Please enter them carefully.
- Provider Number for NT vehicles: First 4 digits of your license plate number plus the letters NT. Ex: 8300NT
- System number: 0907
- The form will be returned by IDPH if information is incomplete or incorrectly entered.

	2	Tourniquet-type bandage: disposable Combat Application Tourniquet, TMT or approved equivalent
<b>Medications/Drugs - BLS</b>		
	1 ea	Albuterol 2.5 mg/3 mL (0.083%); ipratropium 0.02% 0.5 mg/2.5 mL NS & 1 HHN and adaptors to deliver using BVM
	4 ea	ASA chewable 81 mg tablets for chest pain of suspected ischemic origin
	2	Diphenhydramine 50 mg tablets
